**How can I set the filters differently for the port and starboard sides?**

## **Solution**

*I'm surveying alongside a cliff, so I need very different filters on the two sides; can I set up different filters for the two channels?*

Yes; both the Box Filter and Along-Track filter allows you to set which channel or channels they apply to. The Along-Track filter has two copies of itself that can be selected, so you can set one up to run with just channel 1 and the other with just channel 2.

If that still doesn't do what you want, you can use the "T'ducer" filter to use only channel 1, filter the way that you want it, and then select only channel 2, and set the filters for that. It would be a good idea to store two session files if you do that: one for port and the other for starboard.
